

APPLICATION FOR ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS
WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

At the Atlanta Field Office it takes approximately ten months from the time an applicant files with USCIS to obtain lawful permanent resident status. An applicant is eligible to travel outside the US while their application is pending upon securing advance parole. It typically takes less than forty-five days from filing an adjustment of status application to obtain an employment authorization card, which will allow an applicant to then secure a social security number and driver's license.

Firm services include all necessary filings to secure advance parole, work authorization and lawful permanent residence. The firm will reply to all USCIS correspondence, conduct client preparation for the interview and attorney attendance at all USCIS interviews for a flat fee.

This firm charges a flat fee (not hourly) for an Application for Adjustment of Status. This way our clients know exactly what they are paying for and there are no surprises later in the process.

This firm represents individuals with waivers who are ineligible to adjust status because, including but not limited to, criminal convictions and immigration fraud.
